Year 6 SATs Assessments

Our Year 6 pupils are working really hard in their preparation for the upcoming SATs assessments (week beginning 9 May). Thank you for your continued support at home; we can really see the impact this is having.

Over the Easter break, we'd like you to support your pupils by using the learning resources we will send home. We have purchased packs of papers for each pupil. We would really appreciate it if you could ensure that they are used at home and used to enhance learning.

Pupils will receive one envelope containing a full set of Maths papers and one envelope containing two full sets of English papers (Reading and SPaG). Please send them back (with any comments you'd like to add) by Tuesday 12 April.

There are several ways you could approach these tasks. You could ask your child to complete them in exam conditions following the time guidelines before marking and reviewing their answers together. Or, you could break down the papers and give short blasts of revision over a few days. Similarly, please use the questions as a basis of creating your own questions (just change the wording or the numbers where possible).

We hope you agree that these are great resources to aid revision and should allow your child to grow in confidence as we build up towards May. Please also use the resources we've already suggested and sent home. These include: the Grammar booklet, the Maths Revision booklet, the Arithmetic Buster table. Don't forget to use SPAG.com and My Maths as key revision tools. Lots of spelling and mental maths revision would also be helpful.
