We are delighted to roll out the parental element of Classcharts this week. A parent account on Classcharts will allow you to view your child's behaviour feed for each day, as well as any detentions they may have. We hope that this will foster even better communication between school and home and allow us to work together to support each pupil.

Parent accounts can be accessed either via www.classcharts.com or the Classcharts app which can be downloaded for free from either Apple or Android app store.

Once you have accessed either the app or website, you will need to create an account and password. The first time you attempt to log in you will be asked for a parent access code. Your child will be given a form today with your parental access code on. When you first log in you will also be asked to enter your email address and set a password. Once you have done this you will then be able to log in and access the parent feed on the app.
