The Challenge for 2021 is to present a Tunnock’s Teacake to the theme of “Teacake Travels Around the World”. The judging criteria are: presenting a stunning dish, creativity, decorative skills and the use of ethically sourced ingredients.

Your idea should reflect traditions, sights, smells and/or tastes of a chosen country or culture. Ingredients do not have to be sourced from a chosen country if this adds to food miles, alternatives are acceptable.
