Dear Parent/ Carer

Welcome to the first 'Weekly Update' of the year. It has been wonderful to welcome the children back to their new school this week and to hear the buzz of learning and laughter around the corridors. It has been a long journey to get to this point and we are delighted to finally be in our new buildings. I want to reiterate my huge thanks to the pupils for their resilience as their return to school was delayed and to you for your continued support of school life. I also want to extend thanks to the local community venues who supported us with our temporary arrangements including Hexham Abbey, Wentworth Leisure Centre, Queen's Hall and Hexham Racecourse.

Please can you remind your child that they should be on the school site for the **8.40am bell**. We are aware they may be taking new routes to school and that there are ongoing roadworks in the local area, but a prompt start to the school day is essential. We have continued to review our arrival and departure procedures this week and will continue to **end the day for HMS pupils at 3.10pm**. If your child gets school transport, they will be supervised in the library before being walked to the car park for departure. We would be grateful if parents coming to the site to greet pupils on departure would avoid congregating outside the gable end house opposite our exit, as a courtesy to our neighbours.

All KS2 pupils will receive a reading record to record and share their daily reading. All pupils in every year group should be aiming to read for 20-30 minutes every night.
