All of our meals are freshly prepared on a daily basis, using good quality ingredients. It is our aim to ensure that all pupils are provided with a healthy, nutritious meal. We also offer tempting vegetarian options and food allergies/special diets are catered for too.



There is a very good choice to encourage the children to eat a well-balanced diet throughout the day. Our menu is produced in line with the Government's new food standards.

For those children who bring a packed lunch to school we ask parents to refrain from including nuts of any type, confectionery, crisps or fizzy drinks.

We offer a morning break service which includes a selection of: fruit, cereal, toast, bacon sandwiches and savoury snacks. Items are individually priced. A school lunch comprises of 2 courses:

Food allergies and intolerances

Parents/carers are expected to inform the school about any food allergies/intolerances or special dietary requirements that their child may have. Please complete a Food Allergen/Special Diet Form. Copies of the form are available on the school website or from the school office.

Please note: it is recommended that parent/carers supply a medical/ dietitian letter to support the special diet requirements as self-diagnosed or personal food preferences are not able to be accommodated.

If your child would normally have a packed lunch we would still like this form to be completed for our records.

Payment system for school meals

HMS operates a biometric cashless school meals system.

Money can be added to the account by online payments via the School Gateway app/website, which also provides information on school meal balances and purchases. Alternatively, if it is not possible for you to use the School Gateway website or app, please contact the Finance Office on finance@qehs.net and we will arrange for you to be sent a PayPoint voucher to enable you to make payment at one of the many PayPoint terminals sited in shops in the local area.

If a child qualifies for free school meals the monetary value is added to the account daily and they have total anonymity within the system.
