Update on life in school

This week, myself and other leaders have had the opportunity to visit classrooms to see the brilliant teaching and learning going on day-in day-out across our school. This is one of my favourite aspects of my role as I get to celebrate the success of our staff and pupils and to talk to the children about their learning. It is so wonderful to be back in the classroom every day and to see the children thriving in school following the challenges of the lockdowns. We will be visiting more subjects next week and look forward to seeing more great learning. It's also been lovely to see the food technology room back in action – thank you to the year 7 pupils who brought me some scones on the yard!



On Thursday, we reflected with a silence to mark Remembrance Day. On Sunday, our Head Pupil team will join me and Mrs Curry in the Hexham Remembrance Service and will lay a wreath on behalf of the HMS community. Our assembly focus this week has been on STEM and the contribution it is making to climate-ready communities. Mrs Gregory shared an inspirational video of Vanisha talking at COP26 in Glasgow – what a brilliant role model for our young people! Our Eco Schools group will be following in Vanisha's footsteps and taking action alongside students at QEHS as the year develops. We ended the week with our Children in Need Day – thank you for your support of our fundraising efforts.

Thank you for your continued support with drop-off and collection arrangements. We ask that you are mindful of dropping off in the surrounding area and do not block our neighbours' driveways and parking spaces. You are able to drive into school in the morning to drop children off. With regards current COVID-19 restrictions, I would ask that you continue to remind children in KS3 to bring a face covering to school and to complete twice-weekly lateral flow testing.

Online Safety Reminder

Just a reminder to all parents and carers to please be vigilant in monitoring your child's use of the internet and apps. There are lots of fantastic apps available for young people to connect with others and the world around them. Please be mindful that some of these apps carry an age recommendation of 13+. We would generally advise parents to be checking their child's phone content once per week with the child. If you are concerned about anything on your child's phone, please get in touch so we can offer support. There is also some excellent advice for parents online <u>Thinkuknow - home</u>

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We will have a full week of online safety focus in February where students will have access to a range of useful resources and information. There is a national issue around the use of Tik Tok at the moment so we would urge parents/ carers to check their child's devices and accounts very carefully. Thank you for your support.
