






Religious affiliation (2011)








Galileo


Psalm 104: 5

Galileo was an astronomer, physicist and engineer. In Galileo's time the Catholic Church in Italy had a lot of control over the country and its laws.


Galileo was put under house arrest for going against the church, when he said that his scientific research caused him to believe that the earth goes around the sun, not the other way around.

He was forced to stand before the church and say that he was wrong, and that he was sorry for going against the Bible.


In 1993 the Catholic Church recognised that Galileo had actually been right.









