Update on life in school

Happy New Year everyone! I hope you have all had a wonderful Christmas break. It has been great to welcome the children back to school this week and to get the spring term started. The children have looked smart and have their equipment organised for the term ahead. Extra-curricular clubs including sports fixtures will be continuing this term, and you can find information about the many opportunities here. We do have lots of lost property in school and Mrs Westlake has kindly organised this onto new display rails which can be found at the HMS Office. Please encourage your child to come and have a look if you think they have misplaced something.

This term, we have parents' evenings for year 7 and year 8 – the online booking system is now open for parents/ carers to make their appointments. We have been liaising with the company who have hopefully now found solutions to some of the connectivity issues we were noticing during the year 5 and year 6 evenings. We are sorry for any inconvenience caused, but we have been assured that the situation will now improve. On Wednesday 12 January, we will hold our Year 6 SATs Information Evening online at 6pm – a link has been sent home to parents/ carers. We look forward to 'seeing' lots of you online, although the session will be recorded and made available if you can't attend.

Mr Stephenson shared information on this year's residential visit for year 6. He has asked me to let you know that if you have completed the online form, then your child will have a place on the visit. Further information will be sent home in due course. He will also soon be launching details on our year 5 visit for this year – we are very excited for both opportunities!

A reminder that we are nut-free school. Some pupils have brought in some sweets from their Christmas stocks — we ask that you double check ingredients of anything being brought into school. It is also a timely reminder for pupils that we don't want to see large amounts of sweets and treats being brought into school. Healthy snacks are absolutely fine but some pupils do enjoy a visit to the shops on their way to school.

COVID-19 update including testing

I sent home a detailed update earlier this week regarding COVID-19, and followed this with a remote education letter. 

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- Thank you for the support from our amazing volunteers who have helped us to run the test site this week – this is hugely appreciated and allowed us to complete testing at both schools in one day.
- Children in KS3 are also asked to continue taking twice-weekly lateral flow tests and reporting their results.
- Children in KS3 are asked to wear face coverings in classrooms and communal areas unless they are exempt. Any exempt pupil should be wearing a blue badge which they can collect from the HMS office.
- From Tuesday 11 January, the Government has announced that they will temporarily suspend the need for confirmatory PCR test following a positive lateral flow test. If your child tests positive on a lateral flow test from Tuesday, they should self-isolate.
- Below is a helpful diagram which explains the self-isolation rules for testing on days 6 and 7 (or beyond).



Vaccinations

The Immunisations Team have been in contact with school this week. Year 8 pupils will bring home information and consent form for the HPV vaccinations today. We ask that this form be returned by Tuesday 11 January. HPV vaccinations will be administered in school on Monday 7 February.

We have also been notified that second doses of the COVID-19 vaccination will be available for pupils aged 12 and over on Wednesday 9 February. Consent forms and further information will be sent home soon.
