Would you like to see your artwork on display
in an Art Gallery in London?

There is a competition for your artwork to be exhibited in The Royal Academy of Art Gallery and it is open to students aged 4 - 19 studying in the UK.

The Artworks are judged by a panel of passionate artists and arts professionals, with selected artworks displayed online and on-site at the Royal Academy of Arts.

Each student can submit **one** artwork and there is no theme. When you enter, we'll ask for an image of your artwork plus some information about the piece such as title, size, and a little text about the artwork and why you made it.

The artwork can be made using any material; it can be a painting, sculpture, photograph, installation, video, drawing, or a combination. There is no theme so artworks can be of any subject and we don't mind when you made the artwork as long as you are between 4-19 years old when you submit it. We also welcome collaborative pieces made by more than one student.



How does the judging work?

All of the artworks are viewed and judged by a panel of experienced and passionate artists and arts professionals, who work together to select which artworks will be shown online and which will be shown at the Royal Academy. Previous judging panels have included Royal Academicians [Cathie Pilkington](#), [Bob and Roberta Smith](#) and [Phyllida Barlow](#).

Everyone who submits artwork will hear from us about the judges' selection by the end of May 2022.

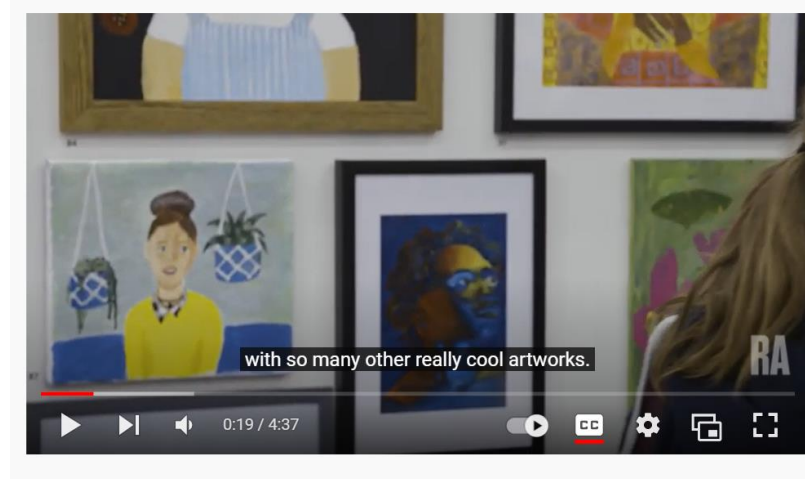
19 July - 14 August 2022

What you need to do if you want to enter.

The deadline to submit artwork is **23rd March 2022**

You must bring to Miss Taylor in HA1 at break or lunchtime **before** the deadline.

1. The art piece you want to submit only 1 piece per student, you can submit artwork that you have created in Art.
2. You need to write down on a separate piece of paper information about the piece such as **title, size, and a little text about the artwork and why you made it.**
