### **HMS WEEKLY UPDATE**

This week has flown by – I can't believe I am sitting down to write the next weekly update already! The school calendar is bursting with enrichment opportunities over the next few weeks (key dates are listed below). Next week is National Careers Week and our assemblies will focus on this theme as well as follow-up work in form time and many events throughout the week. We pride ourselves on providing a well-rounded curriculum experience both in and out of the classroom. I thank the pupils for always getting involved and giving things 100%, and the staff for going above and beyond to provide these enriching experiences.

This week I have spoken to the children about the devastating situation in Ukraine. I know that the children will be aware of the invasion and may have read news or seen images in the media which will be upsetting. I have reassured the children that they can speak to members of the HMS team if they are worried or concerned, and staff have been provided with resources to support these discussions. We will be holding a collection to support Ukrainian citizens – details can be found below.

#### **Situation in Ukraine**

Pupils and colleagues have expressed a wish to fundraise for the people who are displaced. Over the next two weeks there will be tutor time allocated to look at what is happening in the Ukraine, along with opportunities to raise awareness and show support. We are going to fundraise on behalf of the school and pass our donations to the DEC (Disasters Emergency Committee) – please see below a link to their Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal. We have looked at alternatives and see this as the quickest way to help organisations operating in the region. If you would like to make a donation via the school, you can do so through the School Gateway. This will remain open until Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March.

## COVID Update

A summary of the updated guidance we sent last week is below. For the full guidance please refer to our email sent on Sunday 27 February.

- Pupils with Covid-19 are advised not to attend school whilst infectious. They are advised to take a lateral flow test five days after the symptoms started (or the day of the positive test result if asymptomatic) and wait for negative test results on two consecutive days before returning to school.
- Please note that the guidance states that there is no longer a legal requirement for people with Covid to self-isolate, but the public health advice remains to stay at home and avoid contact with others for those with any of the main symptoms of Covid or a positive test result.
- The wearing of face coverings within school remains optional and we will support any pupil or member of staff who wishes to wear them.
- Pupils and staff are no longer required to take part in regular asymptomatic testing but should follow the advice on testing for the general population, which you can find [here](#).
