



He would much rather have been eating Frazzles, kicking a football around and devouring comics. However, in his 20s, he read a book that changed



his life, *Holes* by Louis Sachar, and he began to write. Phil reminded us that we are all storytellers – all we have to do is keep our eyes peeled and our ears open. He also stressed that, 'Writing can be a great way of dealing with difficult feelings.'

In an event highlight, Phil recreated one of his favourite superhero characters, Parallel Parking Man. All credit must go to Joe in Y6 for bringing him to life! Phil shared with us the true events that inspired his newest title *Until the Road Ends*. Phil's stories are filled with suspense, adventure, humour and, most importantly, friendship and love.
