<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clubs take place at lunchtime. Pupils should check the clubs list for the venue and timings. Pupils do not need to sign up – they can just go along. Club leaders will share any additional information in school. In school clubs will start from Monday 18th September. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parents/carers should complete the online form to book places at after school sessions. Parental consent is needed for children to attend. Parents/carers must confirm how their child will get home and alert school to any changes. Parents/carers should let school know if their child will not be attending a booked club. After school clubs will start from Monday 25th September.

<p>FAQ 1: How will I find out if my child has a place at an after-school club?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you don't hear from school, you can presume your child has secured a place. If a club is full, you will receive an email to explain the next steps.
<p>FAQ 2: What if a club is oversubscribed?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lots of our clubs are very popular and some have limited places available. In the event of oversubscription, a draw for places may take place or a rota system will be in operation. You will receive an email from school to explain this.
<p>FAQ 3: My child no longer wishes to attend a club. What should I do?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please contact us on admin@hexhammiddle.org.uk and we will let the club leader know the change.
