to access the app as soon as possible.



School Gateway: we use this platform to manage payments in school. You can log in using
your email address and phone number (it must match the details we hold on record for you).
If you have any issues, please call or email the admin team who will help.

- **School 360:** teachers are busy creating new class groups on School 360. The children will use the platform each week in computing so will become familiar with accessing resources.
- Other: your child may get access to other online learning platforms. Class teachers will send home information in due course.

The school lunch menu has been shared with parents/carers today. We follow a three-week cycle and have a wide range of options available on a daily basis. Our school lunches include fresh, homemade options including main meals, jacket potatoes, pasta and sandwiches. We all sit down to eat at HMS – there is no 'grab and go'!
