### Traffic movement at key crossing times

Thank you for your support in adhering to the new signs on Whetstone Bridge Road that guide vehicle movement on arrival and departure at the key times of student movement, i.e. at the start and end of each day. This has made a big difference in ensuring the supervised crossing point remains safe for staff and students. The key points to note are:

- vehicles are expected to turn left when departing the site at the times of main student movement in the mornings and afternoons
- vehicles moving from the top end of Tynedale Terrace onto Whetstone Bridge Road are expected to turn left at these times.
