Pupil Profiles

Every child has a personalised Pupil Profile, designed to highlight their strengths and identify any areas where support may be needed. These profiles play a vital role in ensuring each pupil receives the right support throughout their school journey. Accessible to all staff, they are an essential tool for planning lessons and tailoring support to meet individual needs—both in and beyond the classroom. To keep them as accurate and effective as possible, Pupil Profiles are reviewed and updated at least once per term, or sooner if needed, by both teaching staff and LSAs.

IEPs

Some pupils will also have an Individual Education Plan (IEP), which sets out tailored long-term targets to support their learning and development. These goals are shared with all school staff and are broken down into smaller, achievable steps, ensuring that your child receives consistent, focused support across the school day. IEPs are reviewed every term, with targets adapted as needed to reflect progress and ensure continued success.

EHCPs

For pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP), the detailed targets outlined in the plan are carefully embedded into the support they receive in school. Our staff work closely with your child to focus on specific aspects of their EHCP, monitoring progress and celebrating achievements along the way. You will also be invited to an annual EHCP review meeting, providing an opportunity to reflect on progress and plan next steps together.

SEND Events

Throughout the school year, we host a series of SEND Coffee Mornings—friendly, informal sessions where you can meet key staff and connect with other parents. These gatherings are a valuable source of support, offering a chance to share experiences and access helpful information. We often welcome guest speakers from local services, who can provide guidance on the wider support available to families. Look out for upcoming dates—we'd love to see you there.

Pupil Spaces

We offer dedicated spaces in school to support pupils' wellbeing, social development, and emotional regulation. *The Base* is open at lunchtimes and provides a calm, quieter space for pupils of all year groups. Staffed by a member of our team, it offers opportunities for quiet time, games, and relaxed conversation. Many children form meaningful friendships here, as they build confidence and social skills in a respectful and supportive environment. In addition, *The Base* and *Restore* are also used for 1:1 or small group interventions, led by our LSA team, to provide targeted emotional and learning support when needed.
